Event Regulations & Conditions of Entry

1. All entries on the day of competition.
2. Skull caps to standard PAS105 or BN 1384.
3. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
4. The organiser reserves the right to cancel any entries or classes and to change the programme at their discretion.
5. If entries are limited prize money will be as follows: 1-8 entries 1st only and rosettes, 9-14 entries 1st & 2nd and rosettes, 15-20 entries 1st, 2nd & 3rd and rosettes, 20 entries and over all 4 prizes and rosettes.
6. Any competitor will be disqualified for dangerous riding or misuse of whips or spurs.
7. The judges decision is final.
8. Objections must be lodged with the secretary with a £20 deposit (refundable if proven) within 15 minutes of the class closing.
9. All entry fees are non refundable, unless a vets certificate is presented before the commencement of the class.
10. The organisers, or anyone acting on their behalf, shall not be liable for any accident, damage, theft or injury to persons attending the event or to animals or property however caused. All persons competing do so entirely at their own risk.

The submission of an entry will be deemed to include acceptance of these conditions.

TRAILBLAZERS

What does it cost to join Trailblazers – You can join trailblazers at this venue –membership is free.
How do I qualify for the second round in show jumping - A Qualification will consist of a double clear in a height class.

What do I do when I have qualified for the second round - Once you have qualified you will be given a copy of a Congratulations letter saying you have qualified, if you choose to take up the qualification you should fill it in and return the letter along with £12 and two stamped addressed envelopes. One envelope will be used to return your qualification card and the other will be used by the Centre to forward details of their second round.

BSJA registered horses can compete at Trailblazers but no currently registered JA's will be permitted to compete at the finals, and no currently registered Grade A or B horses may compete at the Finals.

Riders 13 years and over may ride horses over 148cms in senior classes on or after their 13th birthday.

A junior is someone riding a horse or a pony who will not have attained their 17th birthday on the first day of the National Championships (held at the beginning of August at Stoneleigh Park).
