AFFILIATED COMPETITIONS

Below is a short guide to competing at general affiliated competitions at Vale View

MAKE SURE YOU ALWAYS HAVE YOUR HORSES PASSPORTS WITH YOU AND THAT THEIR VACCINATIONS ARE UP TO DATE. YOU MAY BE ASKED FOR IT

BRITISH SHOW-JUMPING

This show is run under British Show-jumping rules. Please see the current rule book for information.

Entries can be done on line in advance however entries on the day are the main way to enter.

First aid is applicable

Once you have entered you will be given a number that is unique to the horse you are riding and this is the same number you use for the duration of the competition on that horse. I.E. if you enter 3 horses you will have 3 numbers

You do not have to go in the order your number has been given, you put your number on the board with the collecting ring steward in the order you would like to go in. If you have multiple rides it is ideal to get your numbers down early and well spaced out to give you time.

If you are not registered with the BS you can purchase a ticket to ride. These are £6 on top of your entry fee per class/entry and can be purchased on the day

We offer a loyalty scheme which gives you a free entry after you have paid for 8. This is done with one per rider.

DRESSAGE

These competitions are run under British Dressage rules. Please see current rule book for information.

This must be entered in advance and before the closing date which is normally 2 days before the event Please do check. If you enter after the closing date a £5 late entry fee will apply. (check schedules for more info)

Any entries done through the office are subject to a £2 booking fee as well as the late entry if applicable.

If you are not a full member of BD you can purchase a ticket from BD themselves. (Check your eligibility) This must be done in advance and also please bring your ticket with you on the day.

Times are given out at least 1-2 days before the event. Please make sure all information is correct -

Section, class, horse and rider information.

YOU MUST MAKE SURE YOU WEAR 2 BRIDLE NUMBERS ON YOUR HORSE ON EITHER SIDE. THEY CAN BE ON THE BRIDLE OR THE SADDLECLOTH

Whips and callers are allowed during the tests
