

## UNAFFILIATED COMPETITIONS

Below is a short guide to competing at unaffiliated competitions at Vale View -

You do not need to be a member of any organisation to be able to compete in our unaffiliated competitions. Some of our unaffiliated competitions include qualification for other shows; this may require a registration with that governing body.

### SHOW-JUMPING

Entries can be done on line in advance however entries on the day are the main way to enter.

Once you have entered you will be given a number that is unique to the horse you are riding and this is the same number you use for the duration of the competition on that horse. I.E. if you enter 3 horses you will have 3 numbers

You do not have to go in the order your number has been given, you put your number on the board with the collecting ring steward in the order you would like to go in. If you have multiple rides it is ideal to get your numbers down early and well spaced out to give you time.

We run under BS rules however some exceptions are at the judge's discretion.

If time allows we will help you over a tricky fence should it be safe to do so.

Dress Code - Show jacket with white or beige jods or breeches hard hat to current standard

If you want to wear a body protector it is the individual's decision.

### DRESSAGE

This must be entered in advance and before the closing date which is normally 2 days before the event Please do check. If you enter after the closing date a £3 late entry fee will apply. (check schedules for more info)

Any entries done through the office are subject to a £2 booking fee as well as the late entry if applicable.

Times are given out at least 1-2 days before the event. Please make sure all information is correct. If not please e mail [office@valeviewequestrian.co.uk](mailto:office@valeviewequestrian.co.uk) where changes can be made.

**YOU MUST MAKE SURE YOU WEAR 2 BRIDLE NUMBERS ON YOUR HORSE ONE ON EITHER SIDE. THEY CAN BE ON THE BRIDLE OR THE SADDLECLOTH**

**WE RUN UNDER BRITISH DRESSAGE RULES**

There is no steward so please make sure you stick to your time to help with the smooth running of the event.

Dress Code - As for Showjumping

Whips and callers are allowed during the tests

### **ARENA-EVENTING**

This can be entered on the day or in advance, it is cheaper to enter in advance and will guarantee you a place as if numbers excel on the day and if the class is closed priority will be given to those pre entered. (This is only in extreme circumstances)

There are no individual times given just approx class start times which are normally given out the day before the event.

There is time to walk the course before your class starts.

Dress Code - Body protector and skull cap to the current standard

Jodhpurs and breeches in white, beige or a competition colour

You do not need to wear a show jacket you can wear your cross country attire.

You will not be allowed to compete if you do not have your body protector on
